How to reduce the Hazards that may cause a fire	 Curtains needed to be confirmed they are fire retardant material Hirer's T&Cs states decorations must not be hung near the heaters Housekeeping must keep open sided stage area free of any debris Hirer's T&Cs states commercial cooker can only be used by adults competent in using such cooker Hall appliances are PAT tested regularly
