

# Chittlehampton Village Hall Community Survey

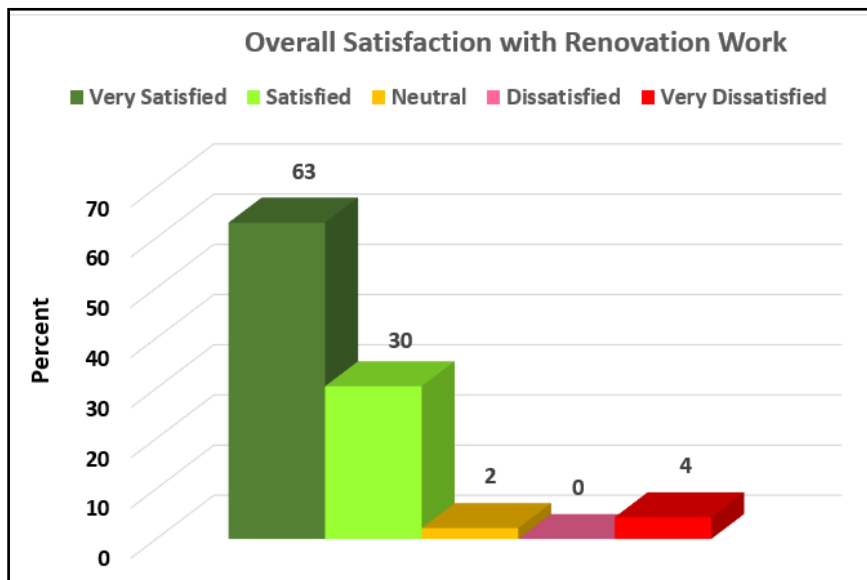
## REPORT - March 2025

This survey was carried out to measure the community's level of satisfaction with the renovation work carried out to date on the village hall and to provide an input on the priority of follow-on work and preferred choice of events to attend in the 'new' hall

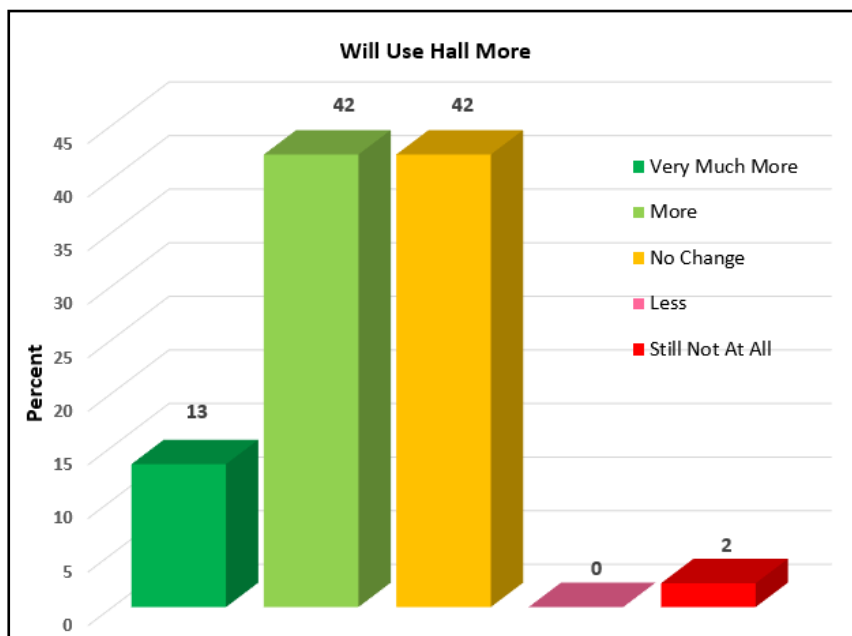
The survey was carried out over a period of 10 days at the time of the hall's official re-opening using hardcopy and online questionnaires. There were 48 responses.

This report shows the results in graphical form followed by a separate section of all the comments that were received by individual contributors.

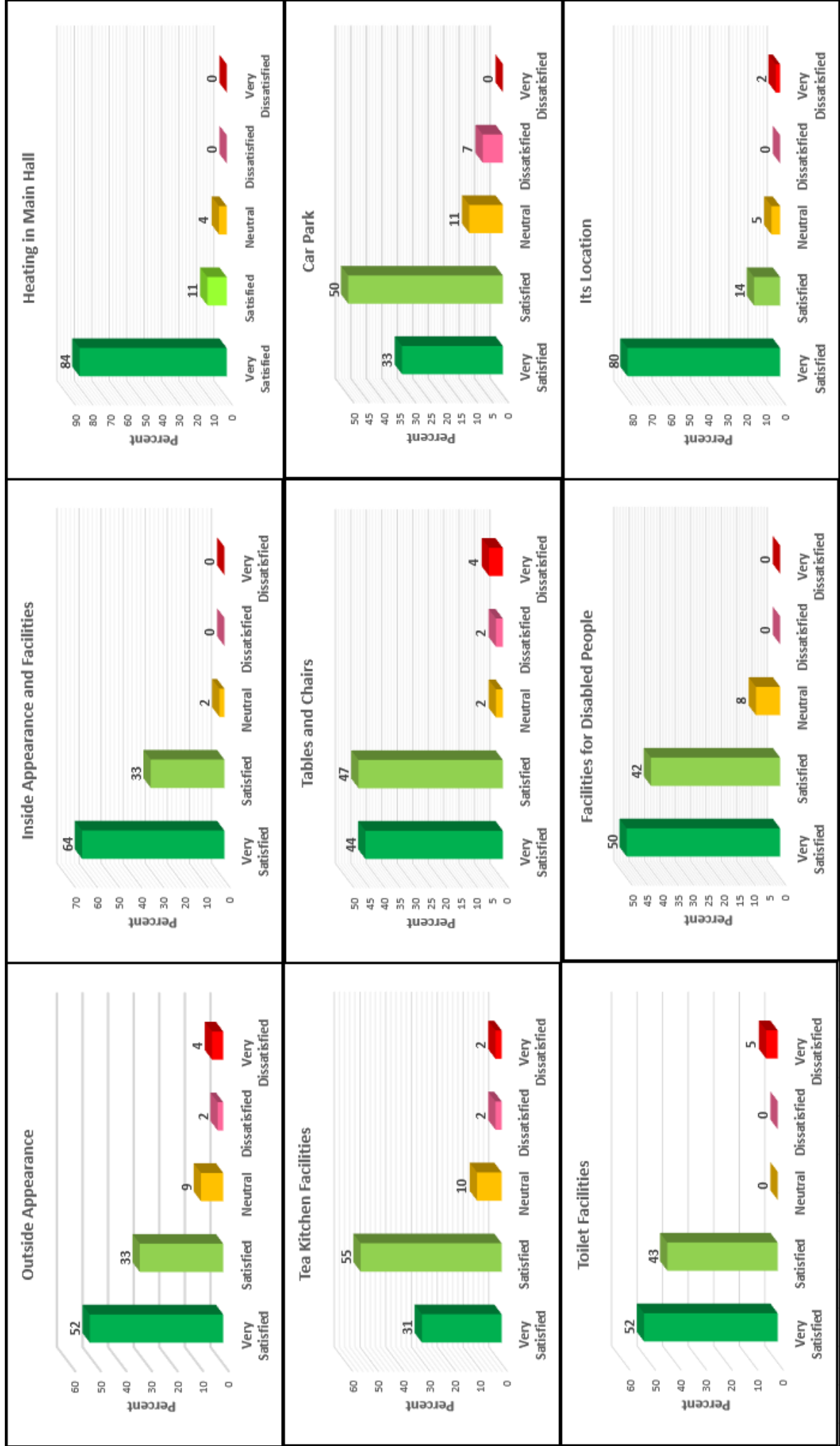
Q) How satisfied are you with the renovation work that has been done to the village hall, so far?



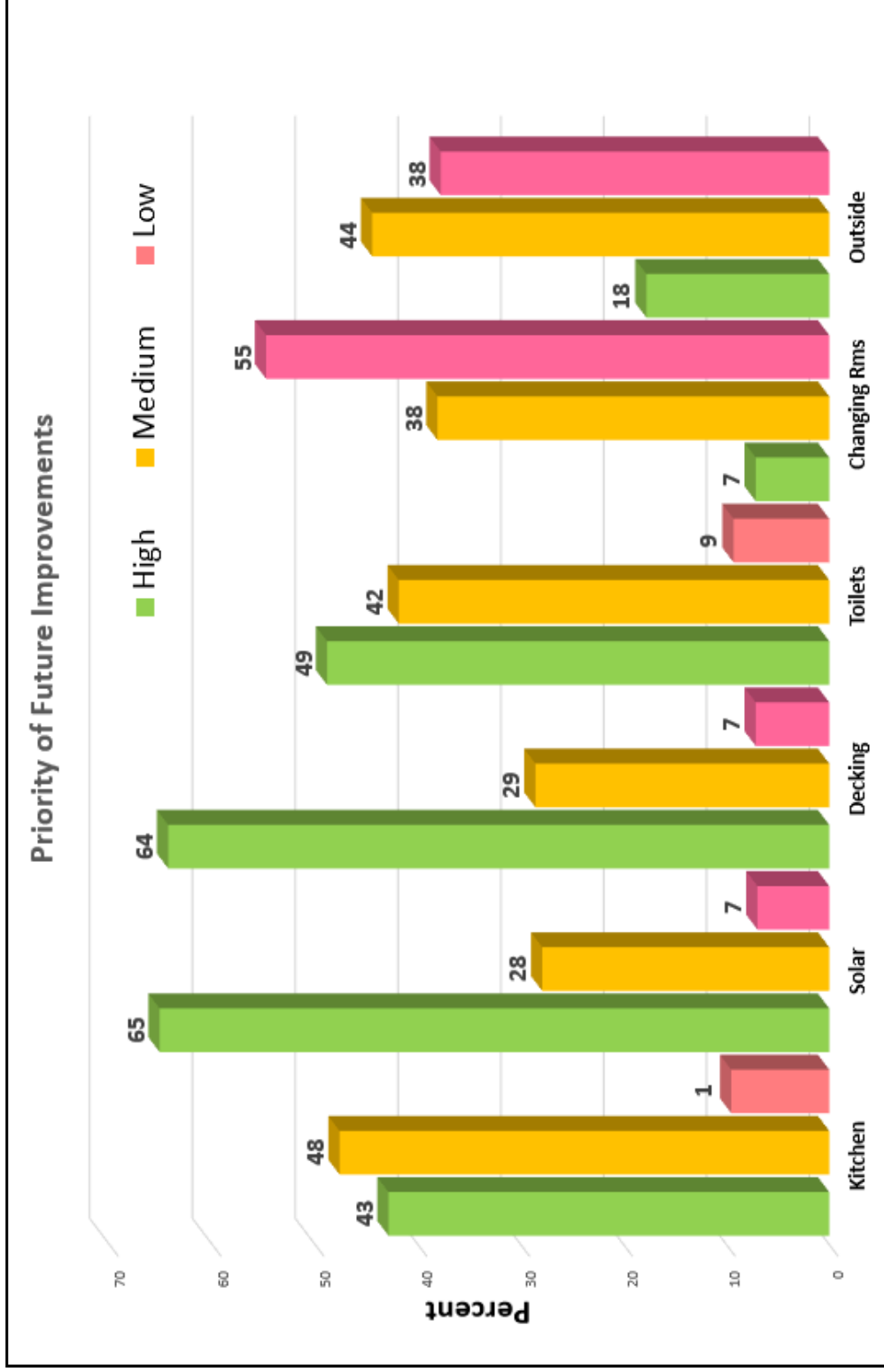
Q) How much more will you use the hall now?



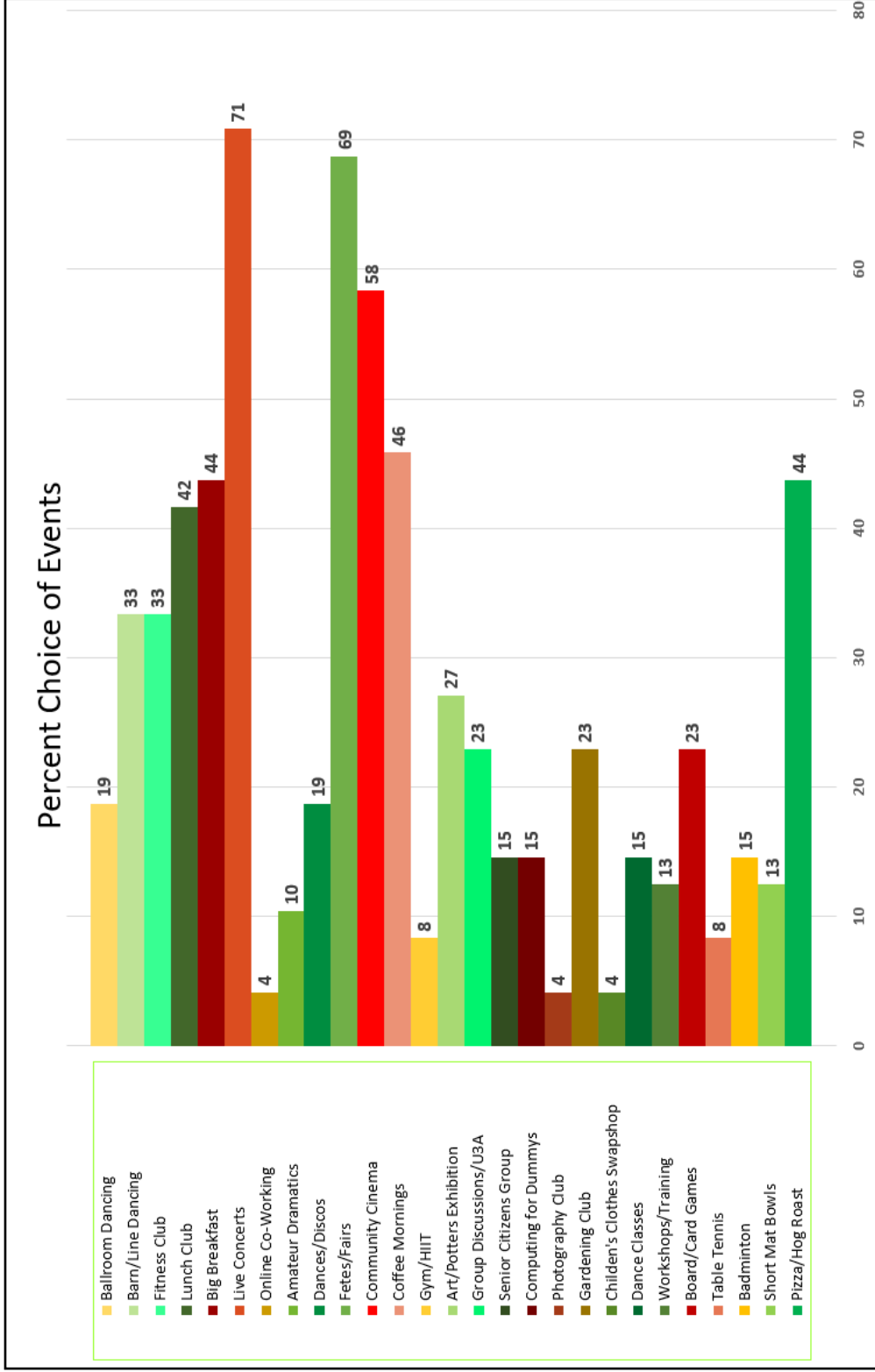
**Q) How satisfied are you with the following?**
